Clothing

- Jacket (rain jacket best)
- Heavy Shirt (wool) or Sweatshirt (hooded)(just in case)
- Official Boy Scout Uniform (CLASS A)- wear each night at dinner.
- Extra Boy Scout Shirt with proper insignia (optional)
- Neckerchief & slide
- Troop 26 T-shirt (CLASS B uniform) (2-3)
- Shorts - several (2-3)
- Hiking Boots (optional)
- T-shirts (2-3)
- Underwear (6 pr.)
- Socks (6 pr.)
- Pajamas
- Swim Trunks & Swim Towel (extra optional)
- Rain Poncho
- Hat (optional)
- Sneakers
- Waterproof Sandals (no water shoes)
- Spare shoe laces
- Swim goggles (optional)
- For Lifesaving merit badge: long-sleeve shirt & long pants

Misc.

- Boy Scout Handbook - packed in Ziplock bag
- Merit Badge Pamphlets
- Homework for Merit Badges (home first aid kit, etc)
- Spiral notepad
- Zippered Notebook (holds spiral notepad, pencils, etc)
- Stamped & addressed envelope & paper for home (must write once)
- Pens / pencils
- Clothespins & 2 plastic hangers
- Heavy duty trash Plastic bags (to 'waterproof' packs & bags)
- Extra Zip-Lock bag for papers, pens, merit badges
- Day Pack
- Trunk
- Sleeping Bag (liner optional but useful)
- Sheet for hot weather
- Insect Repellant (NO Aerosol sprays!!)
- Sun shield lotion
- Toiletries
- Soap in soap dish & mirror
- Comb or brush
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Towels (2) & washcloth
- Medications prescribed by MD
- Deodorant (NO Aerosol sprays!!)
- Good flashlights & spare batteries & matching spare bulb
- Money (Food up, Food back, spending @ Camp ~\$40)
- Mosquito netting for bunk & rope
- Pillow
- Water container (jogging type)
- Camp chair (optional, but very nice!)

Optional Items

- Watch
- Camera & film
- Sharp folding knife & toten' chip card
- Sunglasses
- Playing Cards

DO NOT BRING the following:

- NO! - CD players, Radio, TV, etc.. (except for trip to/from camp)
- NO! - Fireworks, matches, etc...
- NO! - Long knives & sheath (only folding) or Hatchets
- NO! - Giraffes or Billie Goats

NOTES:

- 1) All gear should be labeled with full name : esp. underwear & socks
- 2) Swimming & Lifesaving merit badge : need long-sleeve shirt & long pants (not scout shirt)
- 3) Pack snack foods in metal containers (mice, chipmunks can get in otherwise)
- 4) All medications must be properly labeled in containers prepared by your physician or pharmacist, and be identified to the Scoutmaster BEFORE we depart for camp.
- 5) Anyone caught with tobacco products, alcohol, illegal drugs, fireworks, or weapons will be immediately reported to their parents or guardians, who in turn will be asked to remove the offender from camp.
